BPA is looking for an attorney/advisor to join our Office of General Counsel section. The position will be filled at a GS-12 level. The individual will advise on matters related to labor and employment, and the Freedom of Information Act. The position will participate in proceedings before regulatory bodies, such as the Merit System Protection Board and the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission. Work also includes review of FOIA requests and providing legal advice on all aspects of FOIA process.

The position will be filled as a temporary appointment through the U.S. Department of Energy excepted service attorney hiring process. This position is a one-year temporary appointment that may be extended for an additional year. The temporary appointment may not exceed two years. Permanent placement may be considered but is not guaranteed.
