

Ross Central Storm Water Facility

The Ross Central Storm Water Facility project will be a storm water detention and treatment facility to address current and future development projects on the Ross Complex. The project will mitigate untreated storm water into local streams.

Ross Complex was developed prior to stormwater management regulations. Stormwater is currently collected, conveyed and discharged to the City of Vancouver. As new construction or redevelopment occurs, stormwater management is required.

Under Section 438 of the Energy Independence and Security Act of 2007 (EISA), federal agencies are required to reduce stormwater runoff from federal development and redevelopment projects to protect water resources. From this perspective, this is a non-discretionary investment.
