This communication is the Bonneville Power Administration's ("BPA") final response to your request for agency records made under the Freedom of Information Act, 5 U.S.C. § 552 (FOIA). Your request was received on December 28, 2022 and formally acknowledged on January 24, 2023.

Request

"...records (which includes videos/photos), electronic or otherwise, pertaining to Unidentified Aerial Phenomena (UAP), Unidentified Anomalous Phenomena (UAP), Unidentified Flying Objects (UFOs), etc...any memos, letters, emails from likely individuals involved in such an issue, reports, photographs, videos, etc., that pertain to the topic of this request."

Clarification

Via your email to the agency, received on December 28, 2022, you confirmed your interest in receiving agency records dating back as far as 25 years.

Response

BPA's Cyber Forensics team conducted records and information searches of agency records and found no records responsive to your request.

Fee

There are no fees applicable to your request for BPA records.

Certification

Your FOIA request BPA-2023-00346-F is now closed with no agency records available to provide. Pursuant to 10 C.F.R. § 1004.7(b)(2), I am the individual responsible for the search and determinations described above.

Appeal

The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA appeal is being made. You may also submit your appeal to OHA.filings@hq.doe.gov, including the phrase "Freedom of Information Appeal" in the subject line. The appeal must contain all of the elements required by 10 C.F.R. § 1004.8, including a copy of the determination letter. Thereafter, judicial review will be available to you in the Federal District Court either: 1) in the district where you reside; 2) where you have your principal place of business; 3) where DOE's records are situated; or 4) in the District of Columbia.
