To All Bonneville Power Administration Pacific Northwest and Other Customers:

The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) is projecting that it may have surplus Transferred Frequency Response (TFR) available for sale through November 2027 BPA.

This letter serves as notice of the potential availability of surplus TFR for durations of greater than or equal to one month and less than or equal to twelve months. The available quantities for sale will vary during the period and prices will vary depending on market conditions at the time of the sale.

Consistent with the Bonneville Project Act (Public Law 75-329), the Pacific Northwest Electric Power Planning and Conservation Act (Public Law 96-501), and the Act of August 31, 1964, (Public Law 88- 552), Pacific Northwest (PNW) customers may request to purchase available amounts of TFR prior to the sale of such power to out-of-region customers. If TFR is available, BPA will meet PNW customer requests for specific amounts of TFR at the rates, terms and conditions mutually agreed upon at the time of the sale. Similar terms and conditions may be offered to out-of-region public customers, if there is no competing request for available TFR from a PNW customer. If TFR is available and there is no competing request from a PNW customer or out- of-region public customer, BPA may also meet requests for TFR from out-of-region non- preference customer.
