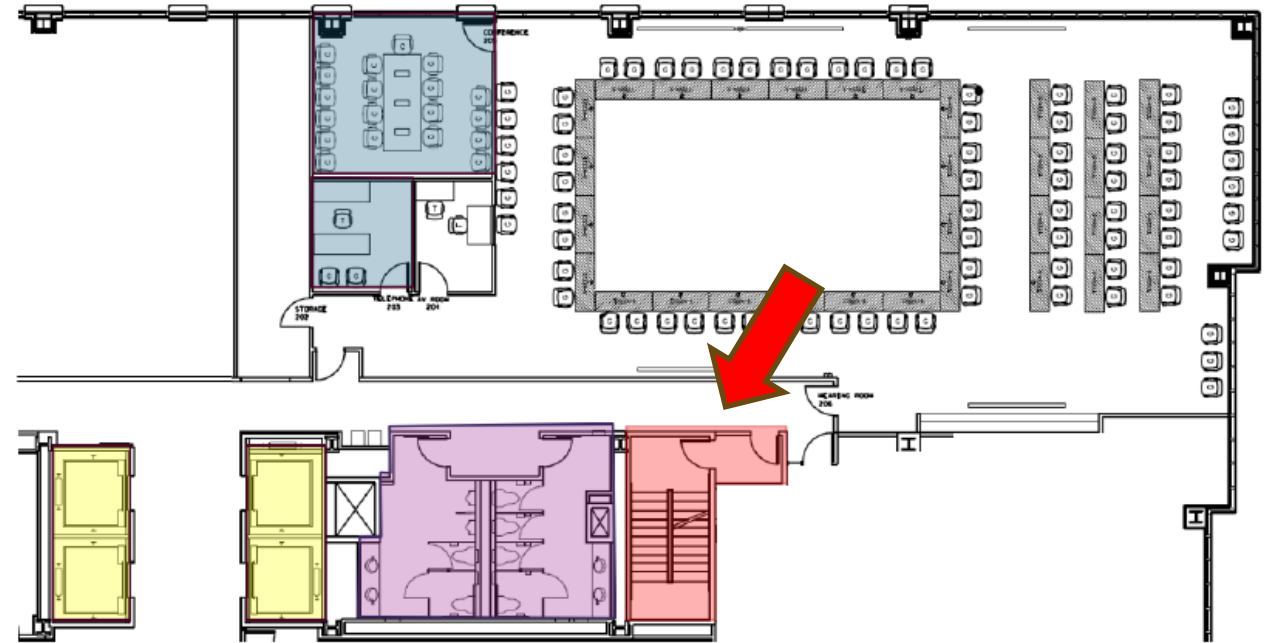

Rates Hearing Room: Need to Know

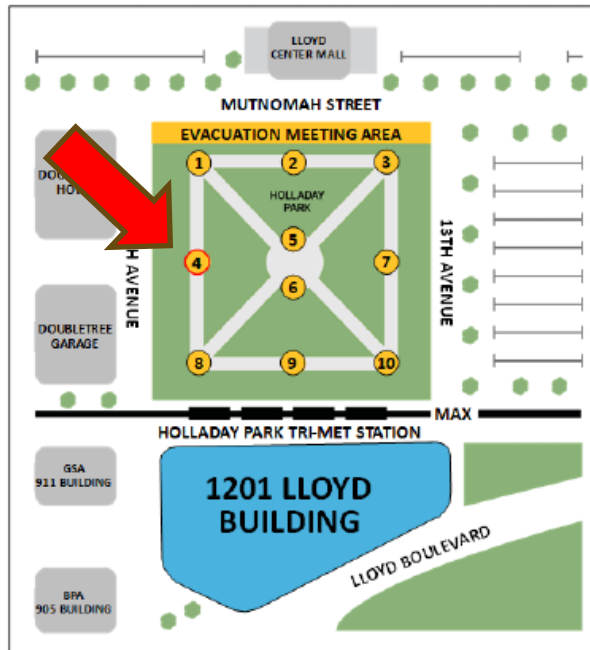
- For your safety and convenience, please familiarize yourself with important locations both in the Rates Hearing Room and this shared tenant building itself.

4 BPA'S ASSIGNED EVACUATION AREA

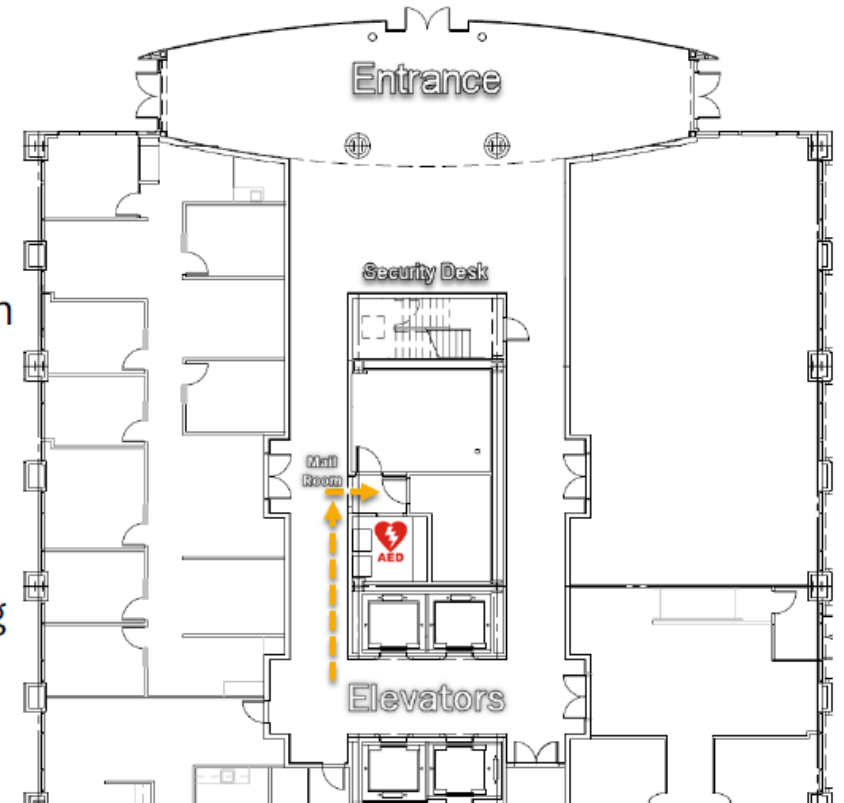

Bonneville received several comments from customers regarding the POC RSS elements discussed during Workshop #2

This workshop will:

- Address customer comments, questions, and feedback
- Discuss *updated* Contract Provisions

Customer Comments, Questions and Feedback

1. Customers requested a policy or contract provision to confirm that capacity credits based on a resource's QCC will be included in the RSS pricing framework.
 - Staff recommends defining the terms of the capacity credits framework during a rate case; the pricing methodology will be described in the GRSPs.
2. Customers requested a pricing framework that allows capacity credits from one resource to offset capacity charges for other resource.
 - Staff intends to allow the capacity service for a resource to result in a power bill credit.
 - This approach will allow resources with high QCC values to partially or fully offset capacity costs of other resources within a customer's portfolio.
3. Customers requested reconsideration of the underperformance charge (upcharge capacity fee) for resources that generate less than historical amounts used to establish QCC values.
 - BPA will not apply an additional charge for underperformance.
 - Standard WRAP QCC methodology will account for resources that underperform over a longer time interval.

Customer Comments, Questions and Feedback

4. Customers requested a service equivalent to the Regional Dialogue's Resource Remarketing Services for resources that exceed the customer's current Above-CHWM obligation.
- Section 3.5.1 described the addition of New Resources up to the Above-CHWM amount established in each Above-CHWM Process.
 - BPA will address New Resources that exceed Above-CHWM obligations on a case-by-case basis.
 - BPA does not intend to offer standard contract provisions in the Provider of Choice Contract.

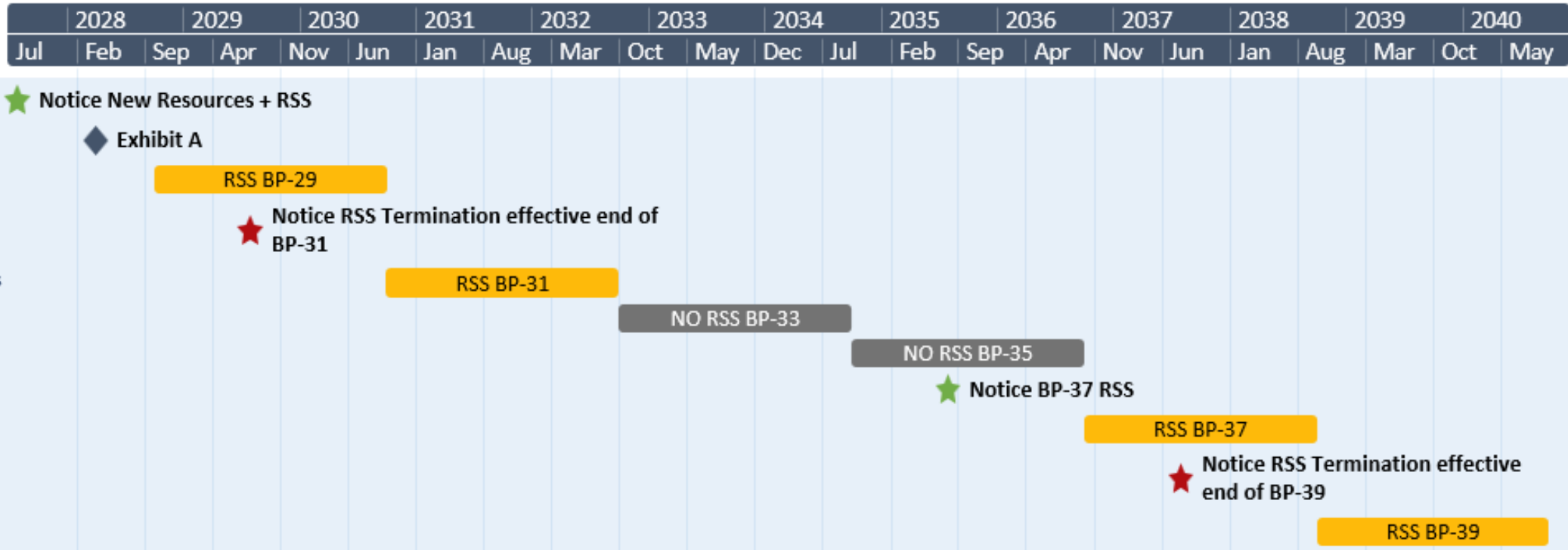
Note: Section 10.4 of the Provider of Choice contract provides a remarketing credit for New Resources that are temporarily removed on a rate period basis due to load loss in subsequent rate periods.

- Remarketing of New Resources with RSS is accomplished in the same manner as remarketing of Tier 2 Rate purchase obligation amounts.

Customer Comments, Questions and Feedback

5. Customers requested additional confirmation and clarification of the RSS election periods.
 - Staff confirms that an RSS purchase election may be changed every two rate periods with the advanced notification.
 - RSS purchase election can change multiple times during the term of the POC contract.
 - Staff made a correction to the Section 3.2.2 to reduce the advance notice to terminate RSS.

Customer Comments, Questions and Feedback

6. Customers raised questions regarding Consumer-Owned Resources serving On-Site Consumer Load, seeking clarification on the applicability of RSS.
- Staff will remove Consumer Owned Resource language from Exhibit J.
 - Depending on needs, BPA may explore the possibility of purchasing QCC from Consumer-Owned Resources to meet BPA's WRAP obligations under a separate agreement, with specific terms to be determined on a case-by-case basis.

Customer Comments, Questions and Feedback

7. A customer expressed concerns regarding the change to energy settlement methodology from forecasted diurnal prices to hourly market prices.
8. A customer highlighted this question in the context of BPA's negative pricing policy.
 - Staff acknowledges that the new methodology represents a significant change with a degree of uncertainty and price risks. However, this remains the most equitable method for allocating value when BPA's resources and loads will be settled in market.
 - Prices established in the market are indicative of the value of energy at the time of generation.
 - Resources electing RSS do not have hourly generation obligations.
 - Negative pricing will be further addressed in the DAM implementation.

Contract Provisions

1. Section 3.1 Consumer Owned Resources

- Consumer-Owned Resources have been removed from Exhibit J.

2. Delivery Requirements

- The Scheduling requirement from Section F and Transfer Service requirements in Section G are not restated in Exhibit J.
- Transfer Service eligibility is defined in Section 3.2.3

3. Section 3.3 Advanced Notice to Terminate RSS

- Corrected to a three-year advanced notice requirement.
