Subject Description:

The preliminary full draft of the 2028 Residential Purchase and Sale Agreement (RPSA) is now available on the [Post 2028 REP webpage](#). BPA is seeking feedback from stakeholders on the preliminary full draft RPSA by close-of-business November 11. Comments may be submitted via email to rep2028@bpa.gov. This feedback will help inform BPA's development of the Full Draft RPSA, which will be provided for formal comment on Monday, November 17. In addition to the features discussed at the public workshops, the preliminary full draft RPSA, includes the following adjustments:

- BPA revised the definition of "Review Period" to be commensurate with the use of that term in the Average System Cost Methodology. See § 2.32.
- Based on participant feedback, BPA has included in this version of the RPSA the "fixed" residential load option using historic averages. See § 6.2. BPA has also included a provision that excludes within-rate period changes to loads (NLSL), BPA's PFx rate (via CRACs, RDCs, or surcharges from BPA), and the utility's ASCs (no changes to utility's ASCs for new resources additions or reductions or changes to service territory). See § 6.3.

BPA released the [Post-2028 Residential Exchange Program Comprehensive Plan](#) outlining the process and timeline for the Residential Purchase and Sale Agreements and the Average System Costs Methodology initiatives in July.
